DU'A WHEN BREAKING YOUR FAST

عَنْ ابْنِ عَبَّاسٍ عَمْرُ قَالَ: كَانَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ ﷺ إِذَا أَفْطَرَ قَالَ: «ذَهَبَ الظَّمَأُ وَابْتَلَّتِ الْعُزُوقُ وَثَبَّتَ الْأَجْرُ إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ» (سنن أبي داود 2357)

ibn Umar narrated that the Prophet ﷺ said when he broke his fast:
Dhahaba al-Dhama' wa abtalat al-'urooq wa thabata al-ajr in sha Allah.

The thirst has vanished, the veins have been moistened and the reward is confirmed if Allah wills. [Sunan Abi Dawud 2357]
